Sponsorship Opportunities

6th International Conference on Generation IV and Small Reactors (G4SR-6)

5th – 8th October, 2026
Marriott on the Falls, Niagara Falls, Ontario

Objective

The Canadian Nuclear Society (CNS) is pleased to organize the 6th International Conference on Generation IV and Small Reactors.

Generation IV and small nuclear reactors can play an important role in safely and securely meeting rising energy demands, whilst simultaneously addressing global challenges around energy security, health, and climate change. While water-cooled small-modular-reactor technology is developing rapidly, multiple non-water-cooled advanced small reactor technologies, such as molten salt reactors, liquid metal fast reactors and high temperature gas reactors, are being developed.

Generation IV small reactors have advanced passive safety features, are resistant to nuclear proliferation, have no greenhouse gas emissions – potentially being alternatives to diesel power - and are promoted as being economically competitive by lowering costs through mass production. They are suitable for niche and off-grid applications, as well as a connection to the electric grid as a supply option to provide incremental capacity as needed to match increasing energy demand.

Generation IV advanced reactors can be the technological innovations that could lead to reprocessing or recycling of used nuclear fuel or the use of thorium to power nuclear

reactors. Just as importantly, they can be used for large-scale production of hydrogen, a potential future low carbon energy source that can provide energy sustainability for the world by replacing gasoline for transportation or natural gas for heating or industrial processes.

The six advanced reactor designs selected for development by the Generation IV International Forum (GIF) are the: Gas-cooled Fast Reactor (GFR); Lead-cooled Fast Reactor (LFR); Molten Salt Reactor (MSR); Supercritical-Water-Cooled Reactor (SCWR); Sodium-cooled Fast Reactor (SFR); and Very High Temperature Reactor (VHTR).

Several Small Modular Reactor vendors (whose designs belong to some of the above Generation IV design categories) have established themselves in Canada and/or initiated dialogue with the regulator, suppliers, utilities, governments and potential customers, for possible development and deployment in Canada. Currently, the following three streams of SMR deployment in Canada exist:

- Stream 1 is underway with construction of the first grid-scale SMR, the BWRX-300 from GE Vernova Hitachi Nuclear Energy's, that will come online at the Darlington new nuclear site before the end of this decade. SaskPower would

subsequently deploy four of the same units in Saskatchewan, with the first coming online early next decade.

- Stream 2 is in New Brunswick, where NB Power has been supporting the development of two fourth-generation designs, Moltex and ARC-100, located in the province. Demonstrations of both these designs will be built at the Point Lepreau site in the early 2030s.
- Stream 3 is the development of micro-SMRs for remote applications. A demonstration reactor is expected to be in service at the Chalk River site in Ontario by 2026. Global First Power has worked in collaboration with Ultra Safe Nuclear Corporation™ and Ontario Power Generation to prepare for and initiate the Micro Modular Reactor (MMR™) Project at Canadian Nuclear Laboratories' Chalk River site. Bruce Power is actively studying options for deploying the Westinghouse micro-SMR design-eVinci™.

As SMR vendors and industry stakeholders work to advance SMR technologies from concept, through laboratory testing and licencing to deployment, there will be challenges. G4SR-6 is an international forum for the industry and stakeholders to work together to identify obstacles and opportunities, and seek solutions through dialogue, engagement and collaboration.

G4SR-6 will build on the momentum of increasing interest in partnership in SMR development in Canada, both in

governments and in the private sector. It will foster low-carbon energy innovation for Canada and the world. As such, it will cover topics of interest to designers, operators, researchers, analysts, policy makers involved in the design, development and deployment of Generation IV and small reactors for research and power-generation purposes.

As Canada's premier small modular reactor (SMR) and next generation reactor technology conference, G4SR-6 will build on the successes of previous events with a fully in-person program including:

- Plenary sessions on important topics with invited speakers.
- Parallel technical sessions with author presentations on research papers.
- Workshops on select topics.
- An "Innovation Night" special social event.
- Potential technical tours

The Conference will have distinguished speakers. In addition, there will be exhibit booths to showcase your reactor design, products or services.
