4th International Conference on Generation IV and Small Reactors (G4SR-4)

Objective

The Canadian Nuclear Society (CNS) is pleased to organize the 4th International Conference on Generation IV and Small Reactors.

Generation IV and small nuclear reactors can play an important role in addressing the energy, health, safety, security and climate change goals of the world. While the water-cooled small modular reactor technology is developing rapidly, a number of non-water-cooled advanced small reactor technologies, such as the molten salt reactor, the liquid metal fast reactor and the high temperature gas reactor, are also being developed.

Generation IV small reactors have advanced passive safety features, are resistant to nuclear proliferation, have no greenhouse gas emissions - potential alternatives to diesel power - and are promoted as being economically competitive by lowering cost from mass production. They are suitable for niche and off-grid applications, as well as a connection to the electric grid as a supply option to provide incremental capacity as needed to match incremental energy demand.

Generation IV advanced reactors can be the technological innovations that could lead to reprocessing or recycling of used nuclear fuel or the use of thorium to power nuclear reactors. Just as importantly, they can be used for largescale production of hydrogen, a potential future low carbon energy source that can provide energy sustainability for the world in replacing gasoline for transportation or natural gas for heating or industrial processes.

The six advanced reactor designs selected for development by the International Generation IV Forum (GIF) are: Gascooled Fast Reactor (GFR); Lead-cooled Fast Reactor (LFR); Molten Salt Reactor (MSR); Supercritical-Water-Cooled Reactor (SCWR); Sodium-cooled Fast Reactor (SFR); and Very High Temperature Reactor (VHTR).

Several Small Modular Reactor vendors (whose designs belong to some of the above Generation IV design categories) have recently established themselves in Canada and initiated dialogue with the regulator, suppliers, utilities, governments and potential customers, for potential development and deployment in Canada. Currently, the SMR feasibility study, a collaboration between nuclear operators in New Brunswick, Ontario, and Saskatchewan outlines in detail three streams of SMR deployment in Canada:

- Stream 1 proposes the first grid-scale SMR project, BWRX-300 by GE Hitachi, to come online at the Darlington nuclear site by 2028. SaskPower would subsequently deploy four of the same units in Saskatchewan, with the first coming online in 2032.
- Stream 2 is in New Brunswick, where NB Power has been supporting the development of two fourth-generation designs, Moltex and ARC-100, located in the province. Demonstrations of both these designs will be built at the Point Lepreau site in the early 2030s.
- Stream 3 is the development of micro-SMRs for remote applications. A demonstration reactor is expected to be in service at the Chalk River site in Ontario by 2026. Global First Power has worked in collaboration with Ultra Safe Nuclear Corporation[™] and Ontario Power Generation to prepare for and initiate the Micro Modular Reactor(MMR[™]) Project at Canadian Nuclear Laboratories' Chalk River site. Bruce Power is actively studying options for deploying the Westinghouse micro-SMR designeVinci[™].

As SMR vendors and industry stakeholders work to advance the SMR technologies from the design concept to laboratory testing, licencing and on through to deployment, there will be challenges. G4SR-4 is an international forum for the industry and stakeholders to work together to identify obstacles and opportunities, and seek solutions through dialogue, engagement and collaboration.

G4SR-4 will build on the momentum of increasing interest in partnership in SMR development in Canada, both in governments and in the private sector. It will foster lowcarbon energy innovation for Canada and the world. As such, it will cover the topics of interest to designers, operators, researchers, analysts, policy makers involved in the design, development and deployment of Generation IV and small reactors for research and power-generation purposes.

The conference will have **several important plenary sessions**, plus **eleven technical program tracks on the above-mentioned topics**. The Conference will have distinguished speakers. In addition, there will be exhibit booths to showcase your reactor design, products or services. A technical tour of the Darlington mock-up (subject to change) will be offered to interested attendees on October 7, 2022. Other potential tours are also under consideration.
